1. Leadline Class (Leadline riders may not show in any other class except on leadline only in Costume & Musical Feed Walk)

6. Costume Class (walk only - may lead, ride, or drive horse, rider may be led by another person)
7. Musical Feed Walk (walk only - may lead or ride horse, rider may be led by another person)
8. Dollar Bareback
9. Flag Race Youth Rider
10. Flag Race Open
11. English Pleasure (adult or youth, walk-trot*-canter, may enter either class 11 OR 12, not both)
12. English Pleasure Pleasure Walk-Trot* (adult or youth, walk-trot* only, may enter either class 11 OR 12, not both)
13. Timed Obstacle Trail
14. Pole Bending Youth Rider
15. Pole Bending Open
16. Western Pleasure (adult or youth, walk-jog*-lope, may enter either class 15 OR 16, not both)
17. Western Pleasure Walk-Jog* (adult or youth, walk-jog* only, may enter either class 15 OR 16, not both)
18. Egg and Spoon
19. Barrels Youth Rider
20. Barrels Open
21. All Nite Pleasure (walk & trot* or jog* only)

*Or easiest gait
