PHBA Golden Trails Horseback Riding Program Rules

PHBA Golden Trails Program Objective:

The Palomino Horse Breeders of America Horseback Program recognizes those individuals who daily or weekly ride the Palomino horse, whether it be in the backyard, or on the trails, training for shows, parades, or ranch work, etc. By recognizing the versatile Palomino horse, we will increase membership, registrations, marketability and stature of the Palomino Horse Breeders of America registered horse.

Requirements:

- Each rider must keep an accurate log on hours spent riding or driving his or her Palomino horse.
- Hours must be kept on an Official PHBA Log Sheet.
- Riders must be current members with PHBA.
- Horses must be registered with the Palomino Horse Breeders of America.
- One-time enrollment fee must be paid of \$15.00 (non-refundable) for each horse and rider combination, provided membership remains current. If membership lapse enrollment fee will be due again.
- Hours can be logged on more than one registered Palomino horse.
- Only one log sheet per horse and rider.
- There is no time limit for completion of a level, however continuous membership must be maintained to receive awards.
- Hours need to be logged in 50-hour increments.
